<b>1-2</b>		<b>Shall we go on sinning so that [God's] grace [to us] may increase? By no means!</b> [Why not? Because we have been...]	
<b>Vs.</b>	<b>United with Christ in His Death to Sin</b>	<b>Vs.</b>	<b>United with Christ in His Resurrection to Life</b>
<b>2</b>	We died to sin.	<b>2</b>	We can no longer live in sin.
<b>3</b>	We were baptized into Christ's death.	<b>3</b>	
<b>4</b>	We were buried with Christ through baptism into death.	<b>4</b>	We were raised with Christ through the glory of the Father to live a new life.
<b>5</b>	We have been united with Christ in His death.	<b>5</b>	We will certainly be united with Christ in His resurrection.
<b>6</b>	Our old self was crucified with Christ so that the body of sin might be done away with.	<b>6</b>	We should no longer be slaves to sin.
<b>7</b>	We have died to sin.	<b>7</b>	We have been freed from sin.
<b>8</b>	We died with Christ.	<b>8</b>	We will also live with Christ.
<b>9</b>		<b>9</b>	Christ was (we were) raised from the dead; He (we) cannot die again [we cannot go back to dwell in the realm of sin and death again]. Death no longer has mastery over Him (us).
<b>10</b>	The death He (we) died, He died (we died) to sin once for all.	<b>10</b>	The life He (we) lives, He (we) live to God.

<b>11</b>	Count yourselves dead to sin.	<b>11</b>	Count yourselves alive to God in Christ Jesus.
<b>12</b>	Do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.	<b>12</b>	
<b>13</b>	Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness.	<b>13</b>	Offer yourselves to God, as those who have been brought from death to life. Offer the parts of your body to God as instruments of righteousness.
<b>14</b>	<b>For sin shall not be your master because you are not under law, but under grace.</b>
