A disciple of Jesus Christ is a person who possesses a genuine, vital relationship with Him as the Savior of their soul and the Lord of their life. The reality of this relationship manifests itself in a growing, lifelong commitment to the three spiritual priorities described on the other side of this handout.

The pursuit of an intimate relationship with the Lord helps us to fulfill the first part of Our Motto: *Knowing Christ*. The cultivation of Christlike character and conduct, and the offering of ourselves to God and others in faithful and fruitful service, help us fulfill the second part of Our Motto: *Making Him Known*.

A mature disciple is an entirely devoted *follower, learner, imitator,* and *proclaimer* of the Lord Jesus Christ. They will reflect both the character and priorities of Jesus Christ.

A growing disciple will have a deepening commitment to the same five purposes that characterize a spiritually healthy church:

Celebrating God through joyful and reverent Worship
Reflecting God through passionate personal Discipleship
Revealing God through loving Fellowship
Serving God through gift-oriented Ministry
Sharing God through need-oriented Evangelism

The goal of discipleship is to become Christlike and spiritually mature. Fred Smith wrote, "The mission of the church, and therefore of church leadership, is to develop mature Christians." (*Learning to Lead*, p. 161)

Paul wrote, "Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me. (Colossians 1:28-29 ESV)

Jesus said, "A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master. It is enough for a disciple that he be like his teacher, and a servant like his master." (Matthew 10:24-25 NKJV)
