

## THE FOLLOWING IS TO BE REVIEWED AND SIGNED BY THE STUDENT AND THE PARENT

One of the goals of Cornerstone Christian School (CCS) is to promote Christian character. In keeping with the goal, students are responsible for following Biblical standards of conduct as part of their growth to maturity. The Bible gives us many principles for living, but the following have been identified as specific guidelines for student behavior. A list of responsibilities is listed below but should not be considered all-inclusive.

\_\_\_\_ 1. I will be obedient and respectful to all adults or authority figures. (I Thessalonians 5:12, I Peter 5:5)

\_\_\_\_ 2. I will respect, be courteous to, and honor other individuals. Physical or verbal intimidation, threats of harm, or peer pressure are prohibited. (1 Peter 2:17, Philippians 2:3, and Galatians 5:14)

\_\_\_\_ 3. I will respect the property of others. (Exodus 20:15, Leviticus 19:11, I Thessalonians 4:6)

\_\_\_\_ 4. I will conduct myself with honor and integrity in spoken and written words. (Colossians 3:9-10, 4:6, Titus 2:6-8)

\_\_\_\_ 5. I will use wholesome speech that respects the name of God, Christianity, and His Church. I will not use profanity, swearing, or coarse language. (Exodus 20:7; Ephesians 4:29; 5:4)

\_\_\_\_ 6. I will be modest in my dress and appearance. I have read and will abide by CCS's Dress Code. (I Thessalonians 4:3-7, I Timothy 2:9-10, I Peter 3:3-5)

\_\_\_\_ 7. I will uphold the Biblical view of gender and adhere to CCS's position on gender issues in its policies, teachings, curriculum, and treatment of students. (Genesis 1:27 and I Corinthians 6:19-20)

\_\_\_\_ 8. I will use cell phones, computer technology, and social media appropriately and responsibly. I will abide by CCS's policy on cell phone usage/possession. (Luke 16:1-2, James 3:13)

\_\_\_\_ 9. I will inform an administrator or teacher if I learn about anyone threatening to harm themselves or others. (Ecclesiastes 8:11, John 13:34, I Thessalonians 4:9)

\_\_\_\_ 10. I will not threaten to or carry out harm to myself. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

**\*The following are to be read by parents of students in K-5 grade to determine if the child is the appropriate age to discuss them. Students in grades 6-12 are required to read and agree.**

\_\_\_\_ 11. I will agree to abstain from the use of tobacco of any kind, alcohol, marijuana, vaping, the illegal use of drugs of any kind as defined by federal law, gambling, and shoplifting. (1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 6:19-20)

\_\_\_\_ 12. I understand that sexual activity between unmarried individuals is contrary to God's Word (I Cor. 6:9-18, Ephesians 5:3-5, I Thessalonians 4:3-7). I also understand that under Oregon's statute (ORS 163.427) it is a criminal offense for a person under 18 to engage in sexual activity.

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Cornerstone Christian School supports parents in expecting students to lead Christ-honoring lives not only at school but outside of school hours as well. Our public conduct should be consistent with our basic philosophy of life – to love God above all and to love our neighbors as ourselves (Luke 10:27). That love should be reflected in all our actions and attitudes toward each other.

We encourage wholesome, God-honoring friendships with the opposite sex; however, displays of romance between students are not allowed at school or during school-related activities.

Students are responsible for abiding by these standards of conduct and the principles of the admission policy. Violation of these standards will result in disciplinary action which could include dismissal from Cornerstone Christian School.
