Cornerstone Christian School (CCS) is committed to providing a Christ-centered education that prepares your child/children for life and service. We believe that the expectations outlined in CCS policy are conducive to personal growth and are in the best interest of CCS. Our school expectations are based on Biblical principles, a Biblical worldview in response to today's culture, and First Baptist Church leadership oversight.

While we recognize that personal convictions from family to family may differ from those of CCS, the purposes and ideals underlying them necessitate families be willing to modify their personal preferences and standards of conduct while associated with CCS. If families cannot make needed modifications, we recommend that you consider a different learning environment.

To maintain harmony between the home and CCS, parents are required to:

_____ Support CCS in all matters of discipline involving your student. Disciplinary policy is outlined in the student handbook and policy manual.

_____ Resolve problems according to an established process outlined in CCS's policy manual. Complaints should be handled and resolved as close to their origin as possible.

_____ Support CCS's attendance policy by committing to ensure that your healthy student(s) are at school and on time each day.

_____ Support CCS in positive ways. Be mindful of remarks in public or on social media.

_____ Read and acknowledge CCS's Statement of Faith, Mission Statement, and Philosophy and agree that it will be upheld in all aspects at school or school functions.

_____ Read, accept, and discuss the Technology and Electronic Media Policy on acceptable use with your student and understand the acceptable and unacceptable use of CCS computers and networks. I give the CCS administration permission to issue an account to my student. In accepting an account, my student is also accepting responsibility for using technology responsibly and appropriately. I recognize that my student's computer usage may be monitored at any time while using CCS computers or networks.

_____ Read, accept, and discuss the Student Standards of Conduct and Dress Code with my student. My student agrees to abide by the conduct and dress codes.

_____ Read, accept, and discuss CCS's Cell Phone Policy with my student.

_____ Read and accept CCS's Tuition and Fee Policy.

_____ Familiarize yourself with the CCS Policy Manual. The policy manual is a living document and is subject to change as the school grows. Any additions, deletions, or corrections that may occur during the academic year are part of a normal change process and will be communicated promptly.
